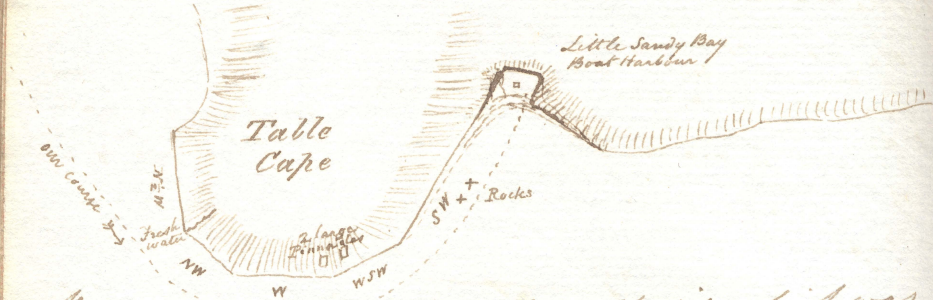
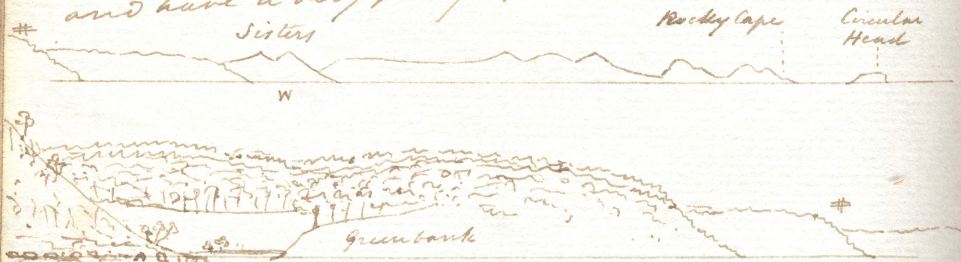


Observed Dip Sugar loaf 285 or W 6 S nearly

We found great opposition from the tide which was running with great rapidity past Table Cape eastward. On going along the WSW side observed the little sandy beach before us bearing SW — it was 2 p 3 when we landed in the Little Bay & I was nearly perished with cold in sitting so long it was some time before I recovered the use of my legs I went along the SW shore a little distance before sunset and picked up several pieces of decomposed granite exhibiting small crystals of various kinds and colours — I also found here the Booby all in full bloom those long catkins in my sketch in last Memo Book are now bunches of yellow flowers and have a very pretty appearance

We had just time to make a tent of the sails and get fire wood for the night before it was dark — there is a fine little rill of Freshwater here which makes it a very good resting place and it is sheltered from all weather except NE when so great a sea sets in, it is impossible to get out but in general the breakers are trifling there being a great depth of water outside, it is but one or two rollers and you are in smooth water a fine clear Eng and promises well for to morrow
